### Strings, Guitars and Drums - Gardonyi's

Violins Violas Cellos Double Basses	All come in various sizes from tiny to full size so they are excellent instruments for young beginners (age 6 upwards)

#### WOODWIND AND BRASS TASTER COURSE

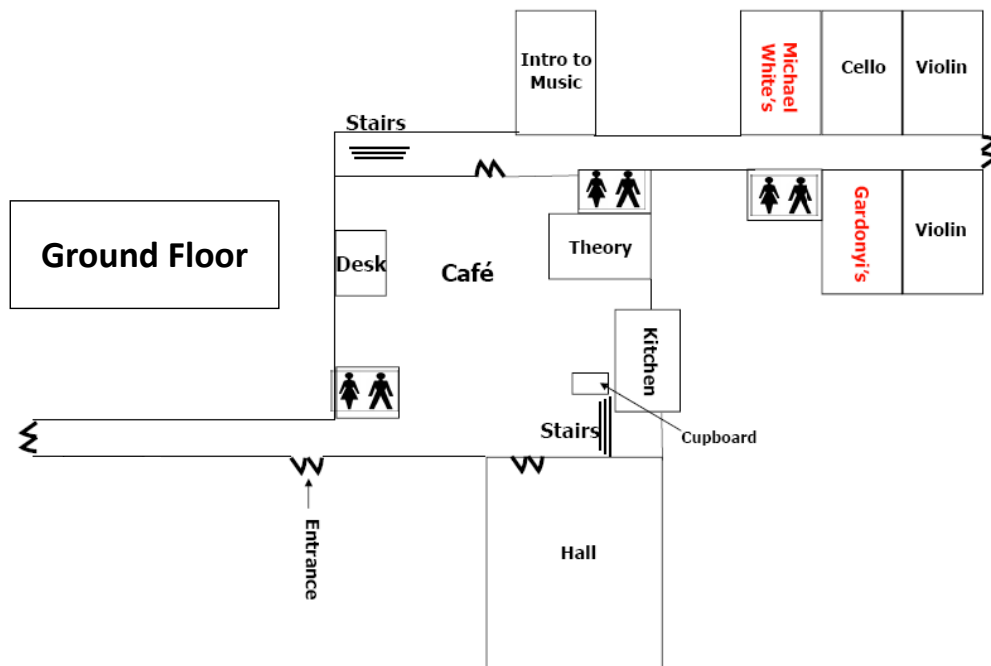
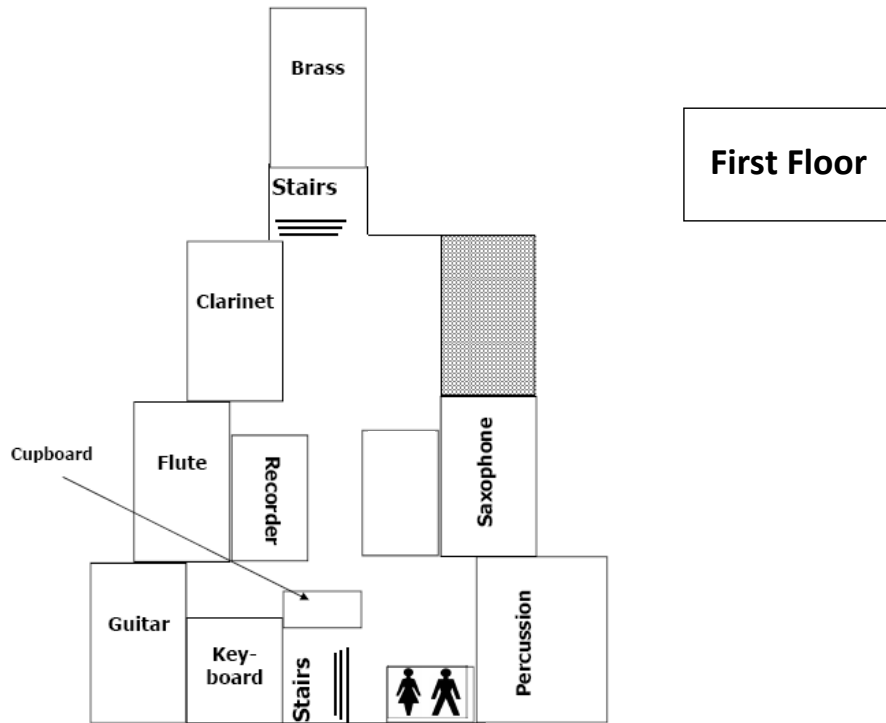
A course for older beginners and pianists/keyboard/guitarists wishing to start a second instrument. Pupils will try each instrument for a set period before moving on to the next. The instruments are: oboe, bassoon, French horn, trumpet, flute and clarinet (age 9 upwards). *All instruments are provided for this course*

Flutes and Piccolos Oboes and Bassoons Clarinets and Saxophones	Woodwind instruments are suitable for older children – starting ages vary considerably and depend partly on the size of the child
Trumpets and Cornets French Horns Trombones	Most pupils start on the trumpet or cornet but you can begin on any brass instrument – once you've got your adult front teeth!
